- 1. Let's set the context. The video we watched began with a verse from Ephesians, a letter to a church. Read Ephesians 2:1-10 and then answer the following questions using the Bible to support your answers.
- a. Who is being described in this passage? How do you know?
- b. What change have the people experienced (v. 4-5)?
- c. How is this change possible (v. 4-9)?
- d. What is the result of the change (v. 10)?
- 2. How would you describe to someone what it means to be God's masterpiece? [Think about how it starts. How does it continue?] Do you see yourself as God's masterpiece? Why or why not?

- 3. In the video, the man prayed, "Dear Heavenly Father, do whatever it takes to mold me into the image of your son. Make me your masterpiece. In Jesus' name, I pray, amen." How would you describe his prayer? Explain. Have you ever prayed like this before? Why or why not? How do you usually pray?
- 4. How did God answer the prayer? Is this the kind of response you would expect from God? Explain.
- 5. How did the man react to how God answered his prayer? Give examples of what held him back from wanting to surrender to God.
- 6. The character "God" pointed out that the man had been listening to too many voices for far too long other than His. Those other voices affected the man's obedience and trust in God, who loved Him so much that He sent His one and only Son to die for his sins. What can you do to ensure you hear more of God's Word and protect yourself from the lies of the world and Satan?

- "I If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. 2 Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth. 3 For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. 4 When Christ who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory."
- a. What does the Bible say about the identity of a follower of Jesus?
- b. How should you live if your life is hidden in Christ?
- c. How does Colossians 3 relate to Coach Smith's testimony?
- 7. Coach Smith finished her testimony by saying, "We live in a generation that is all about ourselves and doing what makes us happy and what pleases us and what brings our flesh joy, but it's all about living for God. It's all about being a light for His glory. Sports are not life; it's a part of life. And the sooner you understand that the easier it is for you to take hold of your true identity. And there is a merger of sports and ministry. There is no separation. It's my faith, sports, always."

Luke 15:11-42

11 Jesus continued: "There was a man who had two sons. 12 The younger one said to his father, 'Father, give me my share of the estate.' So he divided his property between them.

13 "Not long after that, the younger son got together all he had, set off for a distant country and there squandered his wealth in wild living. 14 After he had spent everything, there was a severe famine in that whole country, and he began to be in need. 15 So he went and hired himself out to a citizen of that country, who sent him to his fields to feed pigs. 16 He longed to fill his stomach with the pods that the pigs were eating, but no one gave him anything.

17 "When he came to his senses, he said, 'How many of my father's hired servants have food to spare, and here I am starving to death! 18 I will set out and go back to my father and say to him: Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. 19 I am no longer worthy to be called your son; make me like one of your hired servants.' 20 So he got up and went to his father. "But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion for him; he ran to his son, threw his arms around him and kissed him.

21 "The son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. I am no longer worthy to be called your son.'

22 "But the father said to his servants, 'Quick! Bring the best robe and put it on him. Put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet. 23 Bring the fattened calf and kill it. Let's have a feast and celebrate. 24 For this son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.' So they began to celebrate.

DISCUSS + STUDY

- 1. What does it mean to choose the Jesus way?
- 2. Look back at the song. How is the Jesus way different from the way our world lives? In what ways does following the Jesus way seem difficult?
- 3. Read Galatians 5:13-26 below and then answer the questions that follow.

13 For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. 14 For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." 15 But if you bite and devour one another, watch out that you are not consumed by one another. Keep in Step with the Spirit

16 But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. 17 For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do. 18 But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. 19 Now the works of the flesh are evident: sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality, 20 idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, fits of anger, rivalries, dissensions, divisions, 21 envy, drunkenness, orgies, and things like these. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. 22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. 24 And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. 25 If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit. 26 Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.

- a. What does verse 13 teach you about the Christian life?
- b. What is the relationship between the flesh and the Spirit (v. 17)?
- c. Re-read verse 25. Living by the Spirit means that you have spiritual life and are no longer slaves to sin. What do you think it means to keep in step or walk by the Spirit?
- d. Can you choose to live the Jesus way apart from having the Spirit? Explain. Who can have the Spirit (v. 24)?
- 4. Choosing to follow Jesus is a decision each person has to come to in their lives. If you have decided to follow Jesus how would you explain to someone else why it matters to choose the Jesus way?
- 5. How can you know what the Jesus way is for your life?
- 6. Do you ever feel like you fall short of the Jesus way? Explain. What can we do when we fail at following Jesus?
- 7. How can the people around you affect your relationship with Jesus? Who in your life inspires you to follow after Jesus no matter the cost? Explain.
- 8. What do you want to remember or how is God calling you to respond after today's discussion?
